Study: Kinect Upper Extremity

Dr. Jay Han, at the UC Davis Medical Center in California, is actively recruiting individuals diagnosed with Duchenne muscular dystrophy (DMD), Facioscapulohumeral muscular dystrophy (FSHD), and healthy volunteers to participate in a research study.

The primary objective of this study is to develop new methods to measure participants' range of motion and ultimately develop new outcome measures for clinical trials and new studies.

Inclusion Criteria:

- >6 years of age
- Good health at time of study
- Confirmed diagnosis of DMD or FSHD
- For healthy control participants, no diagnosis of upper arm impairment

There are 8 study visits 3 months apart for 18 months. Each visit will last from 1 to 1.5 hours. All study visits must occur at UC Davis Medical Center in Sacramento, CA.
