


Chapter Leaders The Hats Your Wear!

- Provide a local connection

Community Connector

- Connect families to local resources
- Represent the FSHD Society locally
- Build relationships with the CTRN, clinicians, support resources
- Represent the FSHD Society online



Resource Builder

 Ask chapter members who/what they like/need



- Make note of local resources Google Doc works!
- Make note of special interests and skills of members (we can add to their SF record; share back a full list later!)
- Leverage relationships for sponsors, team captains, and other forms of financial support



Family Advocate

- Listen well
- Act as a liaison between your local community and national staff
- Share concerns and ideas with us
- Share with each other collaborate!
