

ENTRANCES & TRAVEL INFORMATION

How to Find Us: The South Health Campus is located at 4448 Front Street S.E. in Calgary, just east of Deerfoot Trail via the Cranston Ave./Seton Boulevard exit (Exit 232).

Entrances: Enter SHC through the MAIN Entrance off of Front Street or from the parkade (see map).

Main Drop-off / Pickup Area: There is a 10-minute patient drop-off and pickup lane at the MAIN Entrance, on the south side of the building, from Front Street.

Information Desk: The Information Desk is just inside the MAIN Entrance.

Taxi Services: There is a courtesy phone and information at the MAIN Entrance and the Emergency Department Entrance.

Calgary Transit Bus Routes: **Route 14** links to the Somerset/Bridlewood C-Train station. This service stops at all of SHC bus stops, including the MAIN Entrance on Front Street.

Route 406 links to the Somerset/Bridlewood C-Train and the McKenzie Towne bus stops. This service only stops at the north side of the building on Seton Boulevard.

Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Route 302, links to McKenzie Towne and downtown Calgary. This service stops at the MAIN Entrance on Front Street and at the north side of the building on Seton Boulevard.

Route 468 connects communities of Cranston, Auburn Bay, Mahogany & Seton to the BRT to downtown Calgary.

Public Pharmacy: A Rexall pharmacy is open on the west end of MAIN Street Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 7:00 pm.

Bank Machine / ATM: There is an ATM located on MAIN Street across from the Wellness Centre Climbing Wall and another in the Emergency Department Waiting Room.

PARKING & AMENITIES



Public Parking (Paid):

Lot 1: South west or South east entrances, underground on Level P1. You can get to the parkade from all entrances: Prairie, Forest and Mountain.

Lot 3: North east surface level across from Emergency Department. Disabled stalls available.

Disabled parking near all elevators.

Display of valid government-issued parking placard or license plate for persons with disability is required.

Underground parkade height restriction: 2.1 metres, 6' 10"; no propane vehicles are allowed.

Parking Payment Options:

Rates apply 24 hours per day, and are in effect for all, including those with issued placards for persons with disabilities. Weekly/Monthly Passes are available at the parking office with a signed authorization form from the nursing unit.



Pay by Phone: Parking payment can be made using a smart phone using the AHS Parking App. Download the AHS Parking App (search AHS Parking on the Android or Apple IOS App store) and use **Zone 6481**. A valid credit card and licence plate number is required.

Paystations: Parking Pay Stations are located throughout the campus. Paystations accept Canadian coins or credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express only). Paystations provide no change.

To extend the time of your parking at SHC:

1) You can pay for parking directly from your cellphone, from your current location, by using the App. **OR** 2) You can extend your parking time at **ANY** pay station.



Food Services:

There is a **Good Earth Coffeehouse** located on the MAIN Level on the west end of MAIN Street. Open: Monday - Friday 6:30am - 10:00pm and Saturday/Sunday/Stat Holidays 6:30am - 8:00pm. The **Market Cafe** and **Tim Horton's** are located on the east end of the MAIN Street by the Prairie Elevators. Open: 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Vending machines and **water stations** are available on MAIN Street.
