Getting Started

Register

Choose the type of fundraiser you want to do!

REGISTER HERE by clicking "Become a Fundraiser" and personalize your fundraising page. Don't forget to tell people why you are participating and what raising money for the FSHD Society means to you.



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Start fundraising! Ask your friends, family, and community to support you, either by making a donation or sharing your page with their circle.

Steps To Success

- Set personal and team fundraising goals! Aim HIGH.
 Ending FSHD will take all of us.
- Kickstart your fundraising by making a personal donation. This demonstrates your commitment and gets the ball rolling.
- Customize your fundraising page. Share your story of why FSHD is important to you. Don't forget to add pictures!
- Start a Facebook Fundraiser. Did you know, on average, people who fundraise on Facebook raise more than 2x more money? More money means more research! This is easy and can be done right from your fundraising center.

Key Messages

Now that you have your fundraising page set up, you are ready to GO! Here are a few key messages that will help get you started with your outreach. They're also great to share with your friends and family if they ever ask what the FSHD Society does to support patients and families.

- FSHD Society Promise: As long as we are here, no patient will need to ever face this disease alone. With generous support- gifts of time, talent, and treasure from patients, families, friends, major donors, and sponsors, the FSHD Society will keep working to accelerate research leading to treatments, and eventually, a cure.
- FSHD Society Vision: A world free of the suffering caused by FSH Muscular Dystrophy (FSHD)
- FSHD Society Mission: Find treatments and a cure for FSHD while empowering our families and supporters.

Messaging

- What is FSHD? Facioscapulohumeral muscular dystrophy, or FSHD, is a genetic disorder that leads to the weakening of skeletal muscles. Typically beginning in early teenage years with the loss of muscle strength in the face (facio), shoulders (scapula), upper arms (humeral), legs, or core, FSHD can spread to any muscle. Around 20 percent of those affected will need a wheelchair by age 50. Over 70 percent experience debilitating pain and fatigue. There is no effective treatment or cure, but there is hope!
- Who is affected? An estimated 1 in 8,000 individuals or 1 million people worldwide. FSHD strikes men, women, and children of all races and ethnicities. The condition is inherited and can affect family members across generations. Some 30 percent of cases arise in families with no prior history. No individual or family is immune.

Telling Your Fundraising

People give to people, especially people they know!



Adding personal information to your fundraising page, like why you're fundraising, your connection to our organization, or personal photos and stories, helps your friends and family connect more with our mission. Your personal supporters will feel more compelled to give when they understand what ending FSHD means to you. So, don't skip this step!

DIY Fundraiser FAQ's

1. How can the FSHD society support me with my fundraising efforts?

2. How do I find my personal page URL?

Once you've set up your page on our fundraising platform, a unique URL will be generated for you.

3. Where should I mail my checks?

Mail any checks you have collected or written to the FSHD Society. Please make sure to include this information in the 'note' on your check:

4. Are donations tax deductible?

All donation checks that are written to FSHD Society are taxdeductible to the fullest extent of the law.

5. Can I mail in cash?

To assure you that your donation gets credited to you and your fundraiser, we request you turn all cash into a personal check or a cashier's check when possible. Please make sure to include DIY Fundraiser with your first name and last name.

6. What if I want to do a restaurant fundraiser?

A restaurant fundraiser can be an easy way to raise money! Our recommendation is to reach out to the restaurant and ask about their process for fundraising for non-profits. They might require the FSHD Society's TaxID number to donate the proceeds. Please contact us for our TaxID number FSHCommunity@FSHDSociety.org

7. How do I create a QR Code for my fundraising page?
